

SD Opportunity Scholarship Application Information and Requirements

BOR students (including those that have are taking HSDC) will log in using their Single Sign On.
All others will create a manual log-in

Initial Eligibility
A student seeking first time SD Opportunity Scholarship Eligibility as a recent HS Graduate entering postsecondary for the first time

Initial Eligibility – Late SDOS Enrollee a student seeking first time SDOS SD Opportunity Scholarship Eligibility who has completed one or more terms at a participating institution without SDOS Funding. Must meet both initial and continuing eligibility requirements

Initial Eligibility – Returning Student a student who first attended a regionally accredited institution out of state and is now returning to SD to attend school. Must be within 2 years of HS graduation and must meet both initial and continuing eligibility requirements

The application for these two categories will be the same. The review process for the Late SDOS Enrollee will cycle through a different committee that will also pull in continuing eligibility requirements
